On Saturday, Nov. 5, the Canton of Akornebir hosted their annual "As You Like It" Feast, complete with a rapier championship, the annual Arts & Science championship, a comedic tavern brawl, and skullduggery contest. Akornebir was honored to have at court the Baron of Wealdsmere and the Baron of Vulkanfeldt in attendance, and special thank you goes out to the event team of Honorable Lady Ciosa, Dame Katherine, and Baron Thorkell for planning the event.

Hosted in Waitsburg in the city's town hall building, nearly a hundred people came out to celebrate the start of the winter feasting season, and shared a delicious potluck meal together.

After two rounds of rapier combat, six contestants were narrowed down to two finalists, with Lord Ragnar emerging victorious in a hard fought and entertaining contest against Lord Samuel. Lord Cem Hadar Kann was awarded the most dastardly in the tavern brawl, earning him the Skullduggery cloak.

The Canton's A&S cloak was awarded to Lady Yeintel for crafting a beautiful outfit of period clothing. On the Akornebir Facebook page, Lady Yeintel said, "It was so wonderful to be with you all [...] Thank you for making me your new champion. Arts and Sciences is not hard. Just do what you love. Practice makes perfect, so don't give up."

The Canton of Akornebir is a branch of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. We are located at the foot of the Blue Mountains, in Walla Walla, Washington. Our area includes all of Walla Walla County and the Waitsburg/Dayton area. Akornebir became an official branch of the Society in June, 2001 (A.S. XXXVI).

Citizens of Akornebir have for many years been affectionately known as Squirrels.

The Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc.,(SCA) is a non-profit group dedicated to researching and recreating the Middle Ages in the present.

The Canton of Akornebir is located in the Kingdom of An Tir (Irish translation: Our Land), in the area formerly known as the Inland Region. Locally, the Canton of Akornebir is a part of the Barony of Wastekeep. Its territory includes the Canton of Akornebir, and any 993xx zip codes within Benton, Franklin and Walla Walla counties and, through previous negotiations, including Grandview, which is in Yakima county.

long have you been involved?

JS: What is one of your favorite ways to give back and provide service in the SCA?

DK: I love talking to and mentoring Newcomers! Talking to people who stop by a fighter practice or event in a public space, or hanging out with someone at their first event to answer questions and share what I love, feeds my soul.

JS: Who have you seen demonstrate service especially well in the SCA?

DK: We are truly fortunate in the Canton and the Barony of Wastekeep to have many people who do the work part of what we do. Mistress Catriona and Master Dyon, the founding Baron and Baroness of Wastekeep are shining example of service. They served as Baron and Baroness for 17 years and have continually showed up early and stayed late to help with set up and tear down. Mistress Catriona is once again the Chronicler for the Barony. Within the Canton we have Master Thorkell and Mistress Gudrun who have been steadfast in holding offices, running events, reaching out to newcomers and supporting the martial and arts and sciences parts of what we do.

JS: What are some of the less visible and less glamorous parts of service in the SCA?

DK: This is the first time that I have not held an office of any type which is odd for me. While the administrative side of a non-profit organization isn't flashy or glamorous, it is necessary and rewarding in it's own way. Personally I love working at gate to sign people in at events. You get to see everyone who comes while you provide a needed service.





JS: As a registered charitable non-profit, how does SCA provide service and education to the people of Akornebir, here in the Walla Walla valley?

DK: Well COVID put a big dent in what we have traditionally done. We typically put on demonstrations, or demos, in libraries and for schools in addition to taking part in Medieval and Renaissance Festivals. Most recently we were at a one day Renaissance Festival at Dragon's Gate Brewery in Stateline Oregon, along with the Barony of Wastekeep.

JS: What advice would you give to someone who wants to help out within their canton or barony?

DK: Come to the business meeting. That's where upcoming activities are planned. Volunteer to help out. If you're not sure what you are particularly interested in, try something one time and something else the next. There are lots of options and people who have experience are always looking to share their knowledge!


